Job Title: Food Service Worker Division: School & Professional Programs Department: Intrepid Academy at Hale Reports To: Director of Intrepid Academy FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

Schedule: 10 AM-2 PM, Monday through Thursday (approximately 16 hours per week).

Summary: The Intrepid Academy at Hale Food Service Worker transports, sets up, serves, and cleans up lunch service for a high school program, and organizes and purchases snacks and food service items.

About Intrepid Academy at Hale (IAH):

IAH is a semester school for Boston Public Schools (BPS) high school students focused on nature, community, and wellness. Participants spend the school year on 1000+ acres that include ponds, forests, and 20 miles of trails working closely with groups of teachers and students for 8 weeks or more. Given that all our students come from BPS, applicants who reflect the racial and linguistic diversity of the Boston Public Schools are strongly encouraged to apply. Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Records temperatures and record keeping for food put on the serving line.*
- 2. Picks up the food from food provider, transports the food to Hale, and unloads the food into the kitchen at Hale.*
- 3. Sets up the food for serving to students and serves food to students.*
- 4. Loads and unloads the dishwasher and hand wash large dishes in sink.*
- 5. Sanitizes food preparation and dining surfaces.*
- 6. Empties the trash each day.*
- 7. Organizes and purchases necessary snacks and food service items.*
- 8. Must have ServSafe certification training and CPR training completed within first two weeks of starting at Hale.*
- 9. Is accommodating and flexible to student requests in order to create a welcoming and caring environment.*

- 10. Maintains safe and sanitary food practices according to ServSafe standards.*
- 11. Upholds the core values of Hale Education, Inc.*
- 12. Commits to and works towards equity, inclusion, diversity, and justice, both individually and within the greater Hale community.*
- 13. Creates and maintains a reputation for credibility, integrity, and fairness.*
- 14. Professionally represents Hale Education by displaying appropriate and professional behavior at all times during working hours whether in person or through other communication avenues and when handling a variety of situations that may arise during interactions with others.*
- 15. Works with additional staff members as needed.*

Qualifications:
